

HOME Program for New Construction Projects

The Home Investment Partnerships Grant Program (HOME) for New Construction of multi-family rental units is a grant program that is available to provide assistance to Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs) that are constructing multi-family housing units.

Program Facts

Affordable housing is the goal of the Home Investment Partnerships Program (for New Construction Projects). CHDOs may apply for these funds. The Program is designed to provide assistance to low income families as determined the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Home Program (for New Construction Projects) provides for a **maximum grant amount per project of \$750,000**.
